

MOBILE INTEGRATED HEALTHCARE COMMUNITY INVESTMENT GUIDELINES

Welcome. Thank you for your interest in Greater Health Now's Mobile Integrated Healthcare community investment program. The purpose of this program is to connect and work locally with our community-based organizations to support and advance population health, including access to care and workforce development. Greater Health Now's Mobile Integrated Healthcare community investment program awards to organizations located in Asotin, Benton, Columbia, Franklin, Garfield, Kittitas, Walla Walla, Whitman, and Yakima Counties, and the Yakama Nation.

Enrollment Period

Greater Health Now will accept completed applications beginning September 30, 2026, and ending at 5PM PST November 6, 2026. Applications received after November 6th at 5PM will be considered ineligible.

Eligible Organizations:

- Fire/EMS departments, not-for-profit health providers/systems, 501(c)(3) organizations, faith-based organizations, community-based organizations, hospitals, fire districts, Indian tribal governments or organizations, and institutions of higher education.
- Organizations must be located in either Asotin, Benton, Columbia, Franklin, Garfield, Kittitas, Walla Walla, Whitman, and Yakima Counties, or the Yakama Nation.
- Organizations can partner with out-of-region organizations, if the primary organization applying is located within the Greater Health Now region.

The Mobile Integrated Healthcare community investment program of Greater Health Now awards grants to programs promoting:

- Access to care
- Workforce development
- Partnerships with community-based organizations
- Collaboration with healthcare systems

Grant Amount:

The minimum request amount is \$100,000 up to the maximum amount of \$150,000.

Project Period:

Funding is intended to support one-year project from January 1, 2027-December 31, 2027

Greater Health Now's community investment does not support:

- Individuals
- Political organizations and activities including lobbying
- Religious activities
- Fundraising dinners or events
- Capital building, equipment over \$5,000, endowments, or debt reduction drives
- Requests in foreign countries

GRANT APPLICATION PROCESS

Organizations applying for a grant must submit a complete application form. Applications must include an abstract of the project, how the project relates to the priority area, the amount of funding sought and how it would be used, and the expected outcome of the project. Such notification may be submitted electronically or by hard copy to Greater Health Now (by the posted deadline at the address on the home page of this website). Applications are limited to one per organization. Multiple applications from the same organization will be considered ineligible.

Greater Health Now will consider each application and categorize projects for which further detail will be sought. An agreed contribution will be made to the approved organization(s) and the successful applicants notified.

When submitting a Grant Application form, please note that:

- The project must fall within the MIH Community Investment's priority area
- The organization must be an eligible recipient and meet requirements being tax exempt under Internal Revenue Code Section 501(c)(3) and in good standing in Washington State
- All areas of the attached form must be completed
- Greater Health Now will acknowledge receipt of the Grant Application form, but this should not be seen as in any way indicating that the request for consideration will progress further

Application Requirements:

Formal proposal must include:

- Mission statement of the organization
- Clear purpose and objectives of the proposed program
- Detailed outline of the project including proposed outcomes
- Project timeline
- Proposed budget for the project
- Plans for evaluating program accomplishments
- List of major contributors (if applicable)

- Letters of commitment (if applicable)

Upon receipt of completed applications, Greater Health Now reserves the right to request clarification and/or additional details to make a final award determination. Additionally, Greater Health Now may seek to confer with an applicant either face-to-face or virtually in support of the application review process.

Notification of Award

Greater Health Now will notify successful applicants of their award status on November 30, 2026.

Reporting

Final financial and budget report due December 31, 2027.

Semi-annual report due July 15, 2027.

Grantees will also be required to submit mid-year findings to GHN on or before August 2026.
